CPA members win British Construction Industry Award

The cathodic protection of the Silver Jubilee Bridge in Runcorn won the Local Authority Award, recognising it as a project consistent with the UK government's Better Public Building programme. As engineer for the project, Mott MacDonald developed a highly innovative cathodic protection solution that has extended the life of the key transport link from an estimated 10 years to over 25 years. It used an anode system from a CPA member (Protector) and was installed by a CPA contractor (Quadriga). The next phase is also being installed by a CPA member, Balvac.

The BCIA judges were impressed by how the use of technology and engineering prevented massive disruption to not only the local area, but to communications throughout the whole region.
